
Matching funds were provided by Google Fiber, Dropbox and Ryan Companies.

Skillpoint Alliance's Gateway program provides training and education to prepare you for entry-level employment in four to 12 weeks. Trainings are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday-Friday. - Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) Enroll by April 12: Training nurses are taught how to provide basic personal care for patients in healthcare facilities and in-home health care.
- Electrical Enroll by April 19: The Electrical course covers electrical theory, code, conduit bending, circuitry, switches and raceways, and includes hands-on experience and instruction about electrical wiring and systems for com



and instruction about electrical wiring and systems for commercial, industrial and residential buildings.
Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) - Enroll by April 19: The HVAC course covers building codes, pipe fittings, and diagnosing malfunctions and air duct systems, and includes hands-on experience and instruction from dedicated instructors about aspects of HVAC systems for commercial, industrial and residential buildings.
