#### WHAT IS RAD?

The Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) allows HACA to transition our public housing properties into a new HUD program called Project Based Rental Assistance. Through this transition, residents receive specific protections, improvements and choices designed to better their quality of life. That's why at HACA, RAD = PIC.

The earliest Meadowbrook Apartments will convert to RAD is October 2017. Please continue to participate in RAD resident meetings to stay up to date on the most recent RAD information for your property.

#### MEADOWBROOK PROTECTIONS

- Rent remains 30% of your adjusted income
- HACA will maintain a high level of resident services
- All residents are protected by a new lease

#### MEADOWBROOK RAD IMPROVEMENTS (Subject to Change)

- New Playground with Canopy
- Picnic Areas with Barbecue Grills
- Subfloor Repairs
- Onsite Laundry Room
- Exterior Lighting
- Expanded Parking Lot

#### MEADOWBROOK RAD CHOICES

- Option to be placed on the voucher waiting list after living at the same RAD property for two years
- Resident input on decisions about improvements at your property

HACA is not responsible for any missing items or pet(s) escaping from your unit during the inspection.
