HACA & CARLETON BREAK GROUND ON NEW PATHWAYS AT CHALMERS SOUTH

HACA and Carleton Residential Properties recently celebrated a groundbreaking for the new Pathways at Chalmers South at 1640 E. 2nd St.

The new construction, made possible by HACA's participation in the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD), replaces HACA's former Central Office building built in the 1980s.

Pathways at Chalmers South will be a modern development with amenities including central air conditioning, a fitness center, and a laundry facility, to meet the needs of Austin families. It also will feature brand-new electrical and plumbing systems, and include larger two-, three-, and four-bedroom units for families and people with special needs.

When complete, the Pathways at Chalmers housing community will add nearly 400 affordable units to the Austin rental market.

Residents will also have access to onsite workforce development, educational, and health and wellness services provided by various community partners.
