The recent tragic deaths of people of color in Minnesota, Georgia and here in Austin have deeply upset and saddened HACA leadership and staff. Starting in June, HACA will launch a Diversity Task Force to improve conversations about racism, look for solutions, and find peaceful actions we can take together to make progress. **1.) Turn in your 2020 Census.** It is crucial that the Census gets an accurate count of who you are. Federal funding is based on the Census numbers, so we need every HACA household to be counted.

## Free COVID-19 Testing Comes to Lakeside

Last week, CommUnityCare and HACA's Bringing Health Home team provided free door-to-door COVID-19 testing to Lakeside Apartments. CommUnityCare staff administered the nasal swab tests to any resident that gave consent to be tested, while HACA and Bringing Health Home staff helped facilitate communications with residents, and kept everyone safe.

"Weeks ago, a resident at Lakeside called me because they accessing a COVID-19 test was nearly impossible. They were at elevated risk, had several symptoms, and no way to safely reach a testing site." said Rodolfo Rodriguez, Director of Health & Wellness Ecosystem after the event. "This resident inspired a novel collaboration between HACA and CommUnityCare: to bring free and safe COVID-19 testing to them and their high-risk neighbors at Lakeside who similarly faced transportation challenges."
